HOMILY REFLECTION

We Must Be Watchful

In our world, where everything is bought and sold, there are many who offer salvation at bargain prices. Some offer a salvation based on consumption: buy this or that product, use this or that. On many occasions, the message has with it an implicit promise of happiness when certain things are done; but that joy is short-lived and quickly escaped. Others speak of God: “Give a donation,” pray this or that, or go to this ceremony. Afterwards they promise or threaten: Peter went and was cured from cancer and Miguel no longer abuses alcohol. The threats includes things such as José did not pray or go and things became worst. The God they speak of seems like the magic medicine that so many dream of: “take a pill and everything is resolved.” Those who speak like that seem to be magicians who with their power control God and make him work in their service, instead of the other way around. Salvation is not there. The reality is much more complicated.

God is not a magician that solves everything. Our world goes on making its own way. We find God on our side, encouraging us to take the reins of our life, to be responsible of our decisions. On this Sunday we begin the season of Advent. It is a time of preparation for the coming of the Lord. The Word of God invites us to be watchful. We must remain attentive because, in our surroundings, a new presence is felt. The Christian communities are a sign of this new reality. There are many good people working to help others. These are the signs of God’s presence. Advent is our opportunity to watch and remain alert, in order to discover the signs of the authentic presence of God and celebrate them in our prayer. Remain watchful since God may be in your life and you are failing to recognize him.

For Reflection

To watch is to be alive and attentive to the great and small things that are happening in our surroundings. Do we care about everything that is happening or do we live enclosed in our problems thinking that our world starts and ends with us? In what moments do we discover the presence of God near us and in the world?



REFLEXION PARA LA HOMILIA

Hay que estar alerta

En nuestro mundo, donde todo se compra y se vende, hay muchos que ofrecen a precio barato la salvación. Unos nos ofrecen una salvación que se basa en consumir: compre tal o cual producto, use esto o aquello. En muchas ocasiones, el mensaje lleva implícita una promesa de felicidad al hacer tales cosas; pero esa felicidad luego se escapa muy fácilmente. Otros hablan de Dios: “Dé un donativo”, rece esto o lo otro, vaya a esta ceremonia. Luego prometen o amenazan: Pedro fue y se le curó el cáncer que tenía. Miguel ya no tuvo más problemas con el alcohol. Las amenazas incluyen cosas como que José no rezó o no fue y todo le fue a peor. Ese Dios del que hablan se parece a la medicina mágica con que tantos sueñan: “tome una pastilla y todo resuelto”. Los que así hablan parecen magos que con su fuerza controlan a Dios y le hacen trabajar a su servicio, en lugar de al revés. Ahí no está la salvación. La realidad es bastante más complicada.

Dios no es un mago que lo solucione todo. Nuestro mundo va haciendo su propio camino. A Dios lo encontramos a nuestro lado, animándonos a tomar las riendas de nuestra vida, a ser responsables de nuestras decisiones. Este domingo empezamos el Adviento, un tiempo de preparación para la venida del Señor. La Palabra de Dios nos invita a estar vigilantes. Hay que estar atentos porque, a nuestro alrededor, se siente una presencia nueva. Las comunidades cristianas son signo de esa nueva realidad. Hay mucha gente buena trabajando para ayudar a los demás. Esos son los signos de la presencia de Dios. Adviento es nuestra oportunidad para vigilar y estar alerta, para descubrir los signos de la auténtica presencia de Dios y celebrarlos en nuestra oración. Vigilen, no vaya a ser que Dios esté en su vida y no lo reconozcan.

Para la reflexión

Vigilar supone estar vivo y atento a las grandes y pequeñas cosas que pasan a nuestro alrededor. ¿Nos importa todo lo que pasa o vivimos tan encerrados en nuestros propios problemas que nuestro mundo empieza y acaba en nosotros mismos? ¿En qué momentos descubrimos la presencia de Dios cerca de nosotros y en el mundo?

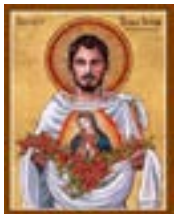
